Role of the School Public Health Nurse Minjung Ellenburg, RN

- Review Health Information forms provided by parents
- Develop care plans when needed
- Train school staff to support student health needs
- Supervises the School Health Aide

Role of the School Health Aide Teresa Knowlan, SHA

- Works in the Health Room
- Takes care of sick and injured students
- Dispenses medications
- Coordinates Hearing/Vision screening.



What parents need to know

Complete the Health Information Form - so we know about health conditions

- Update this form during the year, as necessary

 Complete the Emergency Card Card-Lets us know how to reach you

- Update this form during the year, as necessary

What parents need to know

Parents must provide any medication that their child might need during the school year

- Epinephrine
- Inhaler
- OTC medication (i.e. Tylenol, Advil)
- Daily medications



All medications must be accompanied by the appropriate FCPS medication form.



And last but not least

There are 4 "automatic go home" situations:

- <u>Fever</u> of 100.4 degrees or higher
- <u>Vomiting</u> related to illness (kids throw up for a lot of different reasons)
- <u>Diarrhea</u>
- Undiagnosed <u>rash</u>

Please keep kids home **until symptoms have been resolved for 24 hours** <u>without medication</u>. This will help reduce transmission of viral illness.
