### Academic Progress

How is my child's academic progress assessed?

- All FCPS kindergarteners are formally assessed using the VKRP (PALS and EMAS) in the Fall and Spring, given one-on-one assessment.
- Observational assessments are done daily.
- 1st Quarter parent teacher conferences in lieu of progress reports
- Progress reports are sent home at the end of the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th guarters.
